





"Filing international patent applications" with the participation of more than 250 members consisting of international and domestic participants. Participants consist of academicians, research scholars, students and eminent personalities from the business world. The Programme held at 2.pm on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2020 through Google meet and You tube live streaming presentations. The webinar and the discussions followed it have the following outcomes:


- 1. Fisheries sector currently gives lots of entrepreneur prospects in all parts of the world.


