Overview

The course will offer the students better understanding on nutritional principles and chemical properties of nutrients and other dietary component; After the successful completion of the course students will learn to prepare that plan. Students will also get knowledge to interpret basic clinical biochemistry investigations in humans (such as body fluids) which are used for disease diagnosis and prognosis.

Syllabus

Module 1(5hrs)

Introduction and definition of food and nutrition. Basic food groups: energy yielding, body building and protective foods. Physiology and nutrition of carbohydrates and fats. Physiology and nutrition of proteins and water.

Module 2(4hrs)

Fat soluble vitamins: Vitamin A. D. E. K. Water soluble vitamins: vitamin B complex and vitamin C.Minerals (Ca. Fe and iodine) and their biological functions. Composition of balanced diet and recommended dietary allowance (RDA).

Module 3(6hrs)

Basic concepts of energy expenditure, units of energy. The basal metabolic rate (BMR) and its determination. Specific dynamic action (SDA) of foods. Planning of dictary regimes for infants, adults, pregnancy and old age.
