






AND

M.E.S ASMABI COLLEGE, Kodungallur, Kerala 680671, represented by Dr. Princy Francis, HOD & Asst.professor, PG Dept of Commerce, MES Asmabi College on the other part, and include his successor in office, hereinafter called 'SECOND PARTY'.

The First party is involved in imparting coaching, promotion and development of students appearing for the examination conducted by the Institute of Cost Accountants of India, Kolkata, a Statutory body under an Act of Parliament.

The Second Party is an Educational Institution, affiliated to The University of Calicut, imparting coaching for various academic courses, professional courses and computer courses.

The SECOND PARTY, a well known educational institution situated at Kodungallur, approached the FIRST PARTY and shown their interest to associate with the First Party in conducting CMA course at their organization so that the students of the Second Party can study CMA course along with their graduation.

The parties (I) & (II) referred to above had mutual discussion and agreed to the following:-

- a) The First Party will conduct CMA coaching, which includes CAT / Foundation, Intermediate and Final levels of CMA course for the students of the Second Party at the premise of second Party having address, P. Vemballur P.O., Kodungallur, Thrissur Dist., Kerala, PIN-680671.
- b) The First party, once students are admitted to CMA course as per the guidelines of the Institute of Cost Accountants of India, Kolkata, has the responsibility to conduct coaching as per the guidelines of the Institute. The Second Party to ensure arrangements of classes, admission of students, collection of fee and payment of remuneration to the faculties.

- Orientation classes at the facility of the Second Party at the above address for CMA students registered as per point no: 1 above.
- Impart guidance to students of the Second Party, if found necessary, and to the extent required as may be assessed by the First Party for CAT /Foundation, Intermediate & Final Course.
- Computer training supervision and conducting examination for intermediate students at the facility of the Second Party up on the fulfillment of the guidelines with respect to fee payment and coaching completion.
- To issue prospectus to the students of the Second Party up on the receipt of Rs. 175/- per prospectus.
- To acknowledge the facility of the Second Party as a Satellite Centre / Support Centre of the First Party.
- f) The Institute is reimbursing share of registration fee to conduct coaching and related activities. The amount so reimbursed is to be used for conducting coaching & computer training for the CMA students as per the norms.
- The Second Party to ensure compliance with the norms as prescribed by the First Party and not to involve in any practices with is detrimental to the Institute or to the First Party or to the profession. The Second Party cannot represent the First party unless it is authorized by the First Party in writing, duly signed by the Director of the First Party. The Satellite Centre / support centre is allotted to the Second Party for their facility at the above address, the Second Party cannot issue/sub allot/ transfer the support centre accreditation to any other.
- The profit / Loss arising from conducting the CMA course are to be shared equally by the First & Second party.
- The MOU is subject to cancellation with three months prior notice from either side.
