
Conclusion:



 - d) Exchange of students: graduate, under graduate to be specified in separate negotiated agreements
 - e) Concluding collaborative projects research collaboration
 - f) Conducting lectures and organizing symposia
 - g) Attending seminars and workshops at free of registration
 - Attending placement drives as mutually agreed
- 3. The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MoU shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties in a separate agreement, prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such implementation agreements will form appendices to this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 4. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties of the department which carry out the specific projects. Both Colleges agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws
- 5. Financial and or funding considerations shall become the subject or specific discussion and agreement within the framework of a separate implementation agreement. No financial commitment whatsoever, on the part of either signatory to this general document, is intended or
- 6. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources, concurrence and financial support at the universities
- 7. Should any collaborative research activity under this Agreement result in any potential for intellectual property, both colleges shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.
