REPORT

Genesis of the drive:

Experiential learning through active involvement in social service activities is one of the focal points of student attributes targeted by M E S Asmabi college. It is felt that social orientation is to be rejuvenated among students especially in post -covid situation. The 'Experia' E waste collection drive was planned in a meeting of Heads of all departments convened by the Principal Dr. A Biju on 25th of February 2023. Smt. Deepa K A, (Coordinator, 'Swachh Bharat') and Mr. Mohammed Areej E M, (Head, NAAC Criterion 7) detailed about the modus operandi of the e-waste eradication drive to be undertaken on 28th February. It has been decided to include all students of the college (except III Yyear UG) in the drive to cover all 21 wards under Sreenarayanapuram Grama Panchayath. For the smooth functioning of the programme, each ward is assigned to each department as follows.

Activities done:

All faculties, all PG students and first year and second year UG students were participated in the programme. The 21 wards of Sreenarayanapuram Gramapanchayath were assigned to all 17 departments of the college.

1. Awareness Creation: A meeting of Haritha Karamasena members was held at 10. 30 am on 27th February to give directions regarding the e-waste collection on 28/02/2023. Smt. Deepa K A(Co-ordinator, Swachh Bharath) and Sri. Mohammed Areej E M gave an introduction about the 'Experia' drive. Student Members of Harithakaramasena gave the necessary directions by visiting into all classes. Each departments were organized department level meeting on 27th February 2023 for giving directions and assigning duties to students group for the smooth conduct of the programme next day.

The soft-copy of the pamphlet set in Malayalam language describing the definition and types of e-wastes, risks associated with them and necessity of safe disposal of e-wastes were circulated to ward level WhatsApp groups. Promotion of the brochure and the pamphlet was done via other social media including Facebook. Advance information about the date and time of collection of e-waste by the students was also circulated via the pamphlet. Stress was given on the excluded materials like fluorescent tubes, CFL lamps and picture tubes of CRT televisions. Hardcopy of the awareness brochure was circulated by the students to various households during their visit for waste collection.

2. E-Waste Collection: One member from each student group was given the charge of leading the group. All groups were dispersed for e-waste material collection to different parts of the ward. Hard copies of awareness brochures were also carried by them for circulation. The groups were allocated with the collection works in such a way as to avoid overlapping of the areas of material gathering.

The main items gathered include LCD TVs, computer monitors, mouses, keybords, UPS, cables, electrical switches, modems, connectors, land phones, and tabs. Approximately 2 tons of e-waste were gathered by all the students.

The materials collected were brought to the college and kept in the side of college auditorium. All students were reached the common collection spot by 12.30 PM. After having refreshment the students came back to the college by 1.30 PM. All faculties returned to the college after despatching the collected e –wastes to the college.

Outcome: The message of e-waste accumulation and associated risk was passed on to the students. They were able to transmit the message to local people so as to inculcate a culture of e- waste management and safe disposal.






WHEREAS Party No. 1 herein has set up a facility at XIII/194, K.Pudur, Kanjukde779593 Palakkad for collecting, storing and transportation of E-Waste generated from public and private sector institutions from Kerala with the approval of Kerala State Pollution Control Board and is presently engaged in collection of E-Waste for scientific disposal. The E-Waste stored in its facility would be then transported to the central processing facility at Hyderabad for further recycling and processing till a similar facility is set up in Kerala.

WHEREAS Party No. 2 is desirous of getting affiliated to Party No. 1 and Party No. 1 having offered to facilitate all legally possible help to discharge the responsibility and liability of Party No. 2, towards the Pollution Control Board in the subject matter on the following terms and conditions; this agreement of affiliation witness as follows:

Terms and Conditions

Party No. 2 understands the origin, purpose and function of Party No.1.

2) The affiliation of Party No.2 with Party No.1 shall be for the period of one year initially, commencing from this date. The affiliation shall be renewed for further period on mutual consent in writing with Party No.1.

- Party No. 1 shall not charge any amount as affiliation fee from Party No.2 for entering into this agreement.
- Both parties agree on the mutually accepted rate specified in Annexure 1.
- 5) Party No. 1 agrees to pay Party No.2 on items listed in "ON SALE BASIS" and Party No.2 agrees to pay Party No. 1 on items listed in "ON SERVICE CHARGE BASIS" which is mutually agreed upon.
- 6) Party No.1 hereby undertakes:
 - a. Provide training on segregation and handling of E-Waste free of cost if necessary to Party No. 2.
 - b. To collect and transport the E-Waste from the premises of Party No.2 as soon as Party No. 2 informs about the availability of such material in their premises on the specified rate agreed upon
 - c. To provide the required documents on lifting of E-Waste from the premises of Party No.2.

- Provide certificate of destruction to Party No. 2 after processing the material collected.
- e. Shall process / recycle / dispose off the materials in the approved mode. The ownership of the materials shall pass to Earth Sense only upon the treatment of the materials as said above.
- Earth Sense shall not sell, distribute or otherwise furnish such materials in its original form to any person or entity and will necessarily render the Services with respect to all materials sold under this contract.
- g. Shall bear the cost of logistics to deliver the material to locations where disposal services are provided for Party No.1.
- To take up the responsibility and liability in the subject matter of disposal of E-Waste towards the Pollution Control Board.
- Make payment to Party No.2 by Cheque or Demand Draft in advance listed in "ON SALE BASIS" on the specified rate agreed upon.
- Shall exercise every reasonable safety precautions and best management practice, whether or not required by law, in the performance of its duties under this contract.
- k. Shall notify Party No.2 immediately if any of its permit, license, approval or identification number required for the performance of the services have been revoked, modified, expired, suspended or not been renewed.

7) Party No.2 hereby undertakes:

- a. Provide access to staff of Party No. 1 for visual inspection of the E-waste and submit a Waste audit report.
- Collect and store the E-Waste at a final collection point with easy accessibility for collection by Party No. 1.
- c. To permit entry and exit of vehicles of Party No.1 in and out of the premises of Party No.2 for collection of the E-Waste.
- d. Pay the service charges for E-Waste listed in "ON SERVICE CHARGE BASIS" to Party No. 1 within 7 working days from the date of disposal of material subject to submission of tax invoice.
- e. Logistics cost shall be borne by E-Waste Generator if the quantity is below one ton.
