


Innovation ecosystem in the campus

The innovative ecosystem within the institution has transitioned from a basic level of awareness and orientation to a well-organized and cohesive environment, supported by research and development departments. The IPR Cell, Institutions Innovation Council (IIC), IEDC, YIP, ED club and Incubation Centre organise activities, including motivational talks, entrepreneurship development programmes, innovation workshops, and idea hackathons, to raise awareness and provide orientation. These programmes ensure participation from all departments, students, and faculties.

Hackathons are organised in specific sectors and at different levels of integration. The ideas are vetted through collaboration between the Incubation cell, the three research departments, their respective labs, and the CEtC research extension centre. The incubation cell facilitates the chosen individual to conduct experiments at these centres or any other laboratories present in different science and vocational departments, guided by the projects or research designs.

These prototypes are once again created for the purpose of experimenting, and the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) cell, Research Promotion Council and Research Labs assess their potential for patenting or embedding them into our products. The incubation cell, ED clubs, IEDC, and research extension wings collaborate to facilitate pre-incubation activities, ensuring that goods are developed in tandem with marketing goals.


