'Idea fest'

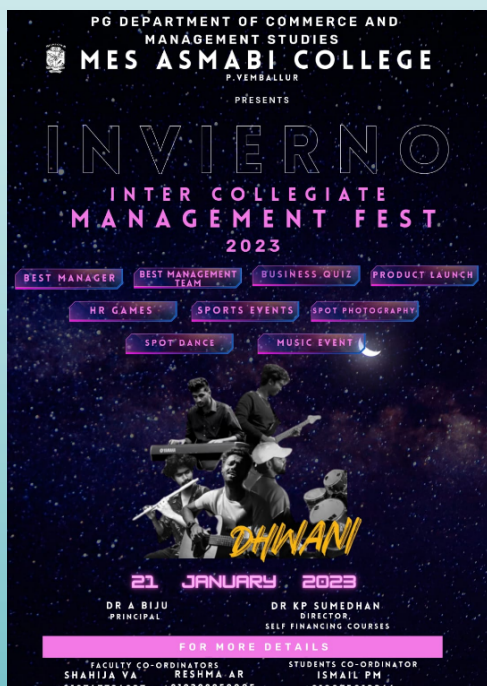

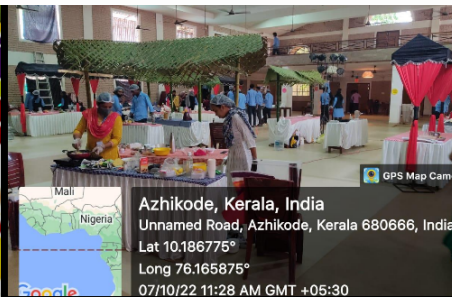


'INVIERNO 2023'

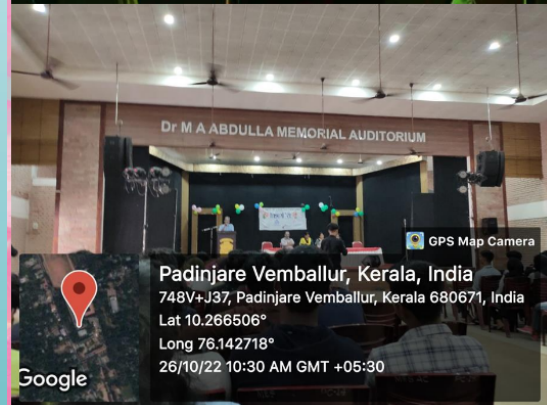
Live cooking competition on 7th October 2022

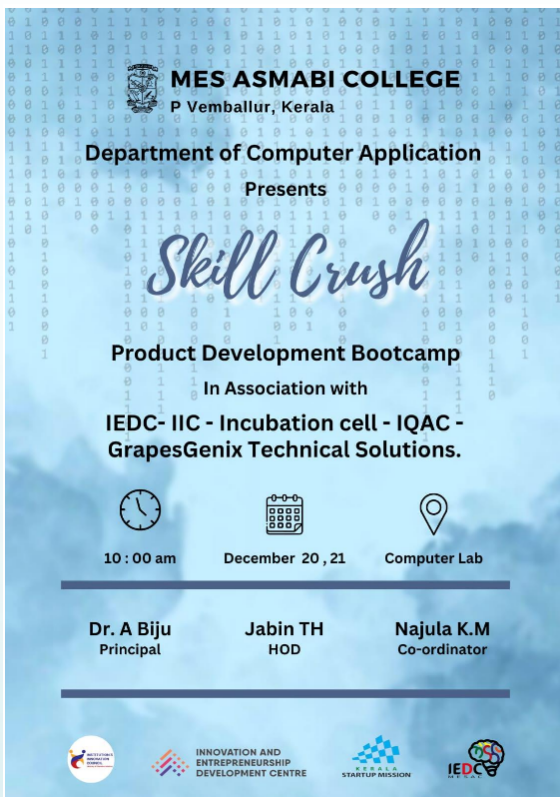


IIC Regional Meet at KMEA Engineering College, Kuzhvelippady

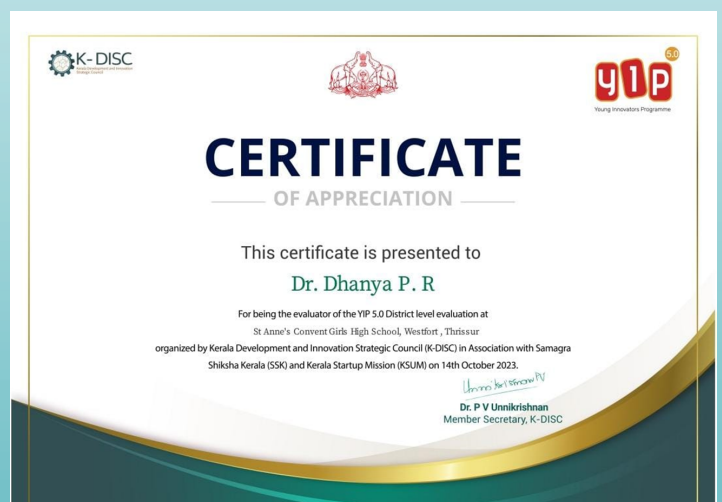
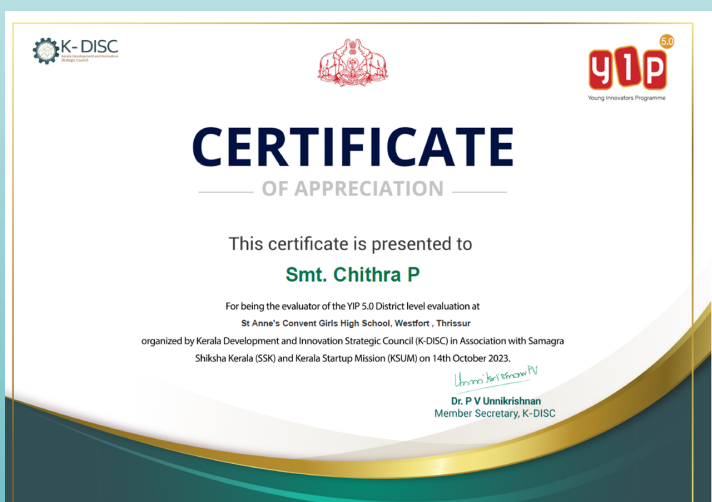

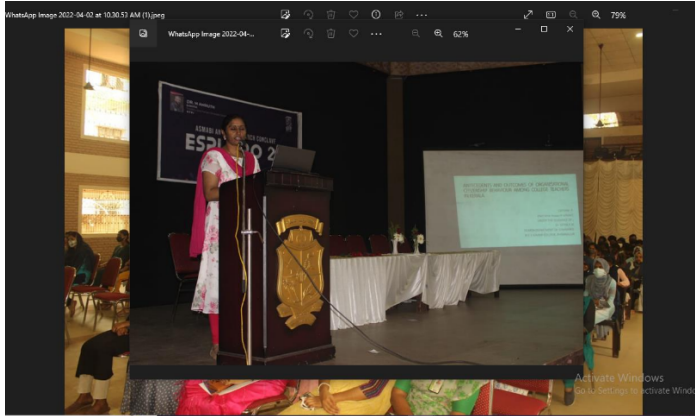
