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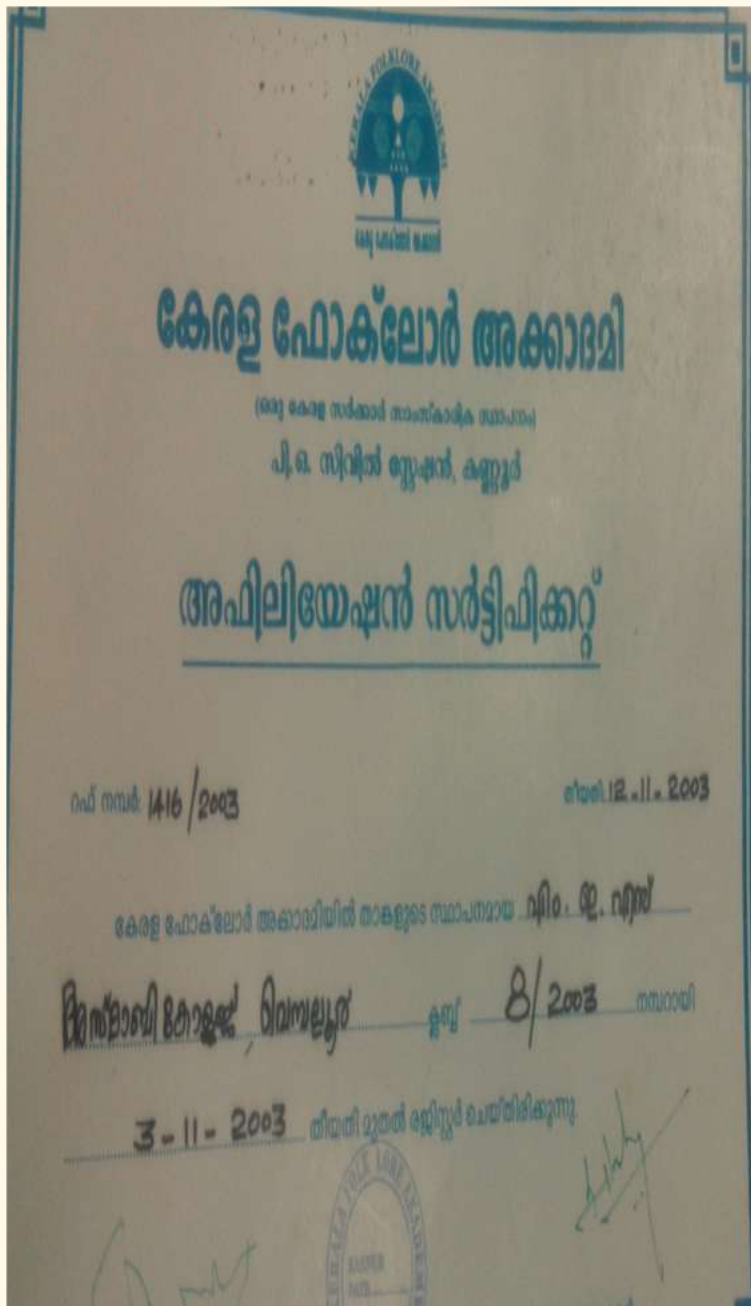

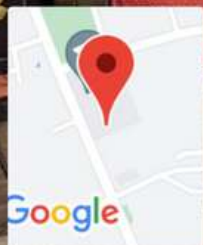

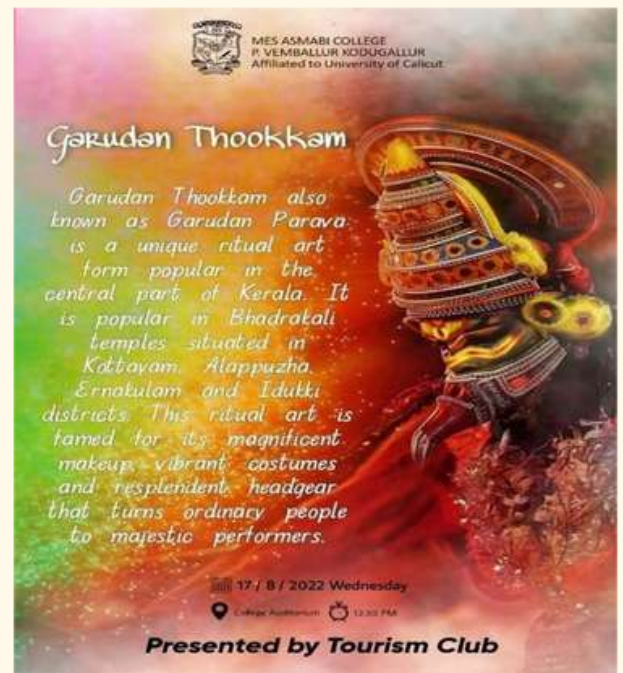
Kalampattu: One day workshop

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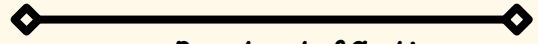
IRUPATHIYONAM NUTTANDILE BHASHA-SEMINAR

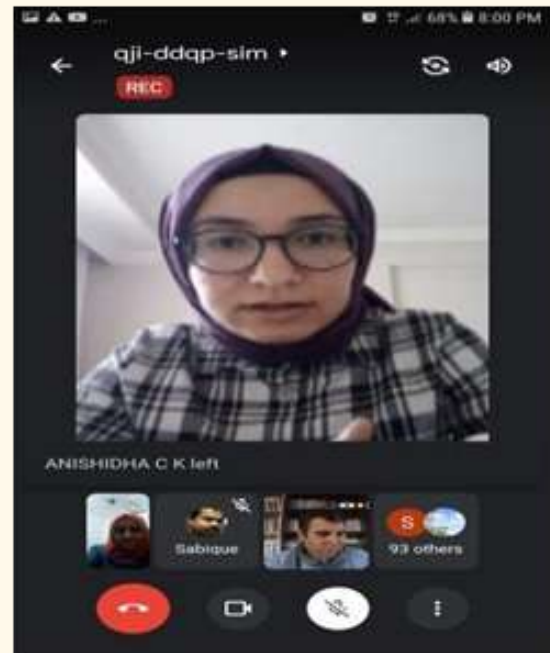

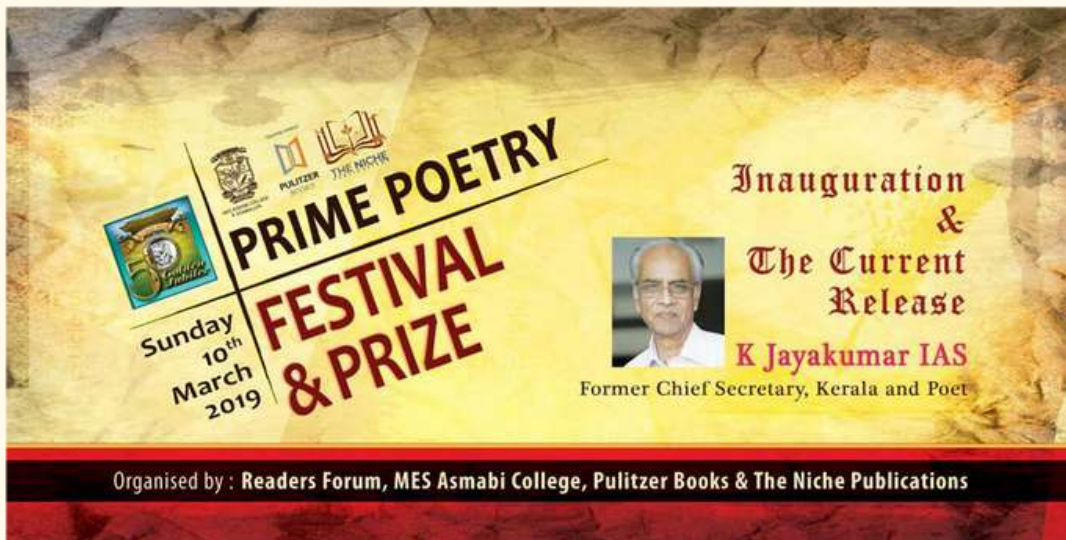

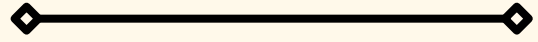
Promoting Language and Literary Skills through College Manuscript Magazines

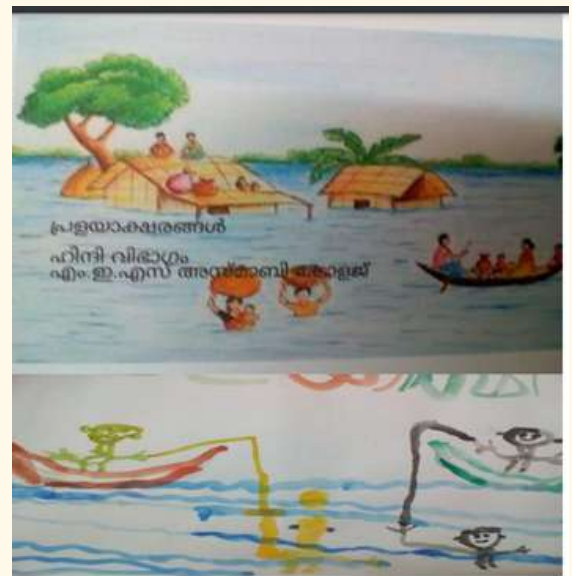


KITAB ALOCHANA

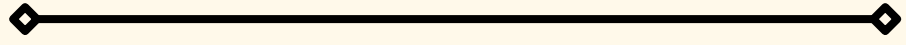
REHABILITATION CAMP FOR PAIN AND PALLIATIVE PATIENTS

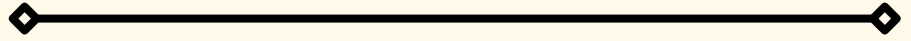

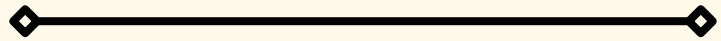
FLOOD RELIEF: STUDENTS AID

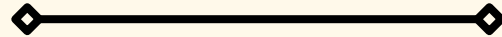
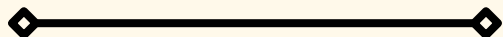
POST-FLOOD CLEANING WORK

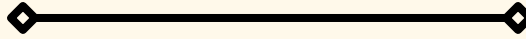


GANDHI CORNER

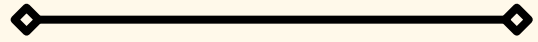


NATIONAL SEMINAR

COLLEGE UNION ELECTIONS



Every year college union elections are held in parliamentary mode. Student representatives are selected from respective classes and in turn they elect the representatives of the college union. Candidates who have successfully met the norms of candidature are qualified to compete in the elections. Attendance, and academic performance are the key parameters for filing the nominations. The nominations are scrutinised, and the list of candidates eligible for competing in the election is notified in the respective departments. Students are given ample time to raise their disputes. Instructions to Polling Officers

1. The time of polling will be from 9.30 am to 10.30 am.
2. Prior to the commencement of polling, the serial number of the candidates and name of the candidates should be written on the board.
3. Names should be written in alphabetical order.
4. Ballot paper should be signed by the polling officer.
5. Signature of the student should be obtained on the nominal roll before issuing the ballot.
6. In a class where two candidates are to be selected and one among the candidates is a girl, the girl shall be declared as the winner to the first post. Subsequently election to the second post must be conducted.
7. Votes must be cast by marking **X** against the serial number of the candidate in the ballot paper. The Serial Number will align with the serial numbers written on board.
8. In a class with two representatives, if more than two votes are cast, the vote will be invalid. Even if the student prefers to cast his/her vote to one candidate alone, the vote is valid.
9. Even if polling ends early, counting of votes should start only at 10.30 am.
10. After declaration of result, the signature of all the candidates should be obtained on the counting sheet where the result is recorded and it should be handed over to the Returning Officer.
11. If two candidates get equal number of votes the winner can be declared by coin tossing.
12. Polling Officer and class representatives should reach the seminar hall immediately after the election.
13. If the polling officer is not able to resolve any dispute that arose during the course of election, the Returning Officer may be contacted. (9496844901)

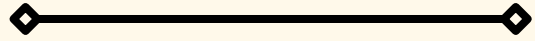

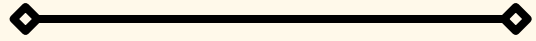

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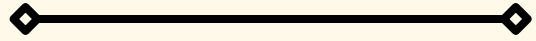
HAR GHAR THIRANGA

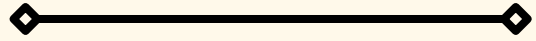
AMRIT KALASH YATRA

CHILDREN'S HOME VISIT

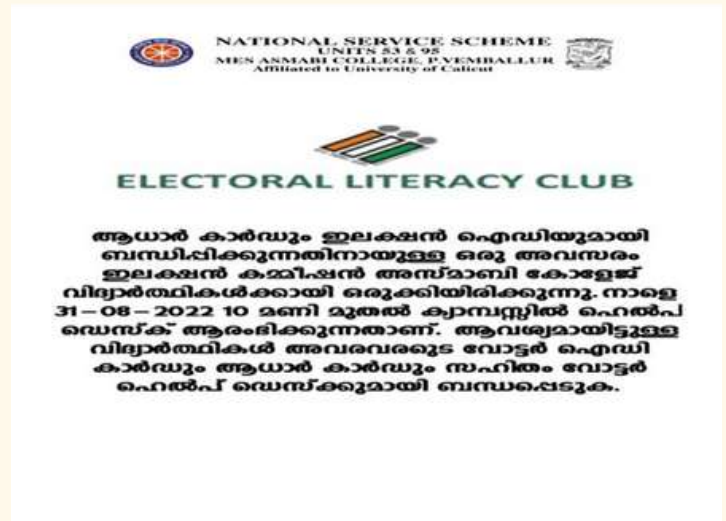
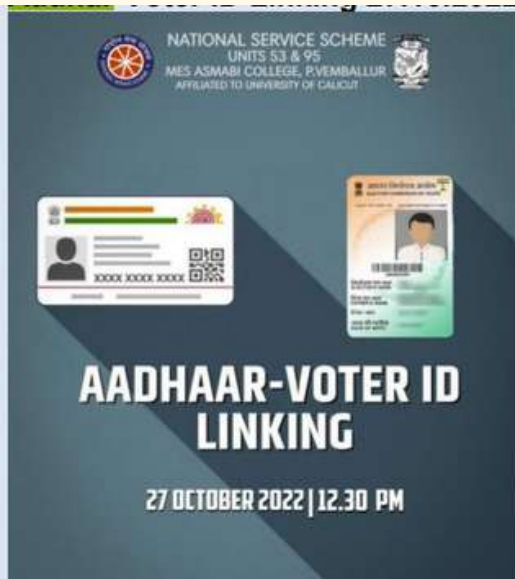

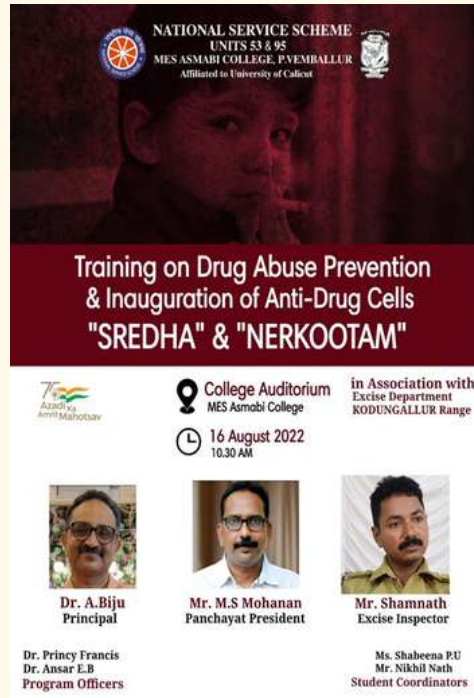
AADHAR-VOTERS ID LINKING INITIATIVE

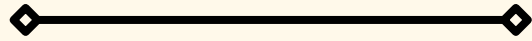


PASSPORT REGISTRATION CAMPAIGN

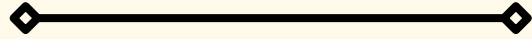


LECTURE ON 'INDIAN CONSTITUTION AND DEMOCRACY'
