

#### Kalampattu: One day workshop










#### KERALAPIRAVI DINAGOSHAVUM MALAYALABHASHA VARACHARANAVUM



Reading Day was observed by Depatment of English on 19 June 2018. Well Known poet, lyric and composer Sri RK Damodaran was the resource person of the programme.









#### Promoting Language and Literary Skills through College Manuscript Magazines


#### **KITAB ALOCHANA**




# MATHRUBHUMI INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF LETTERS






#### **RANG 21 - THREE DAY PROGRAMME**

# **EYE SCREENING CAMP**










# **LECTURE: GANDHISM: PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE**






#### **MOHAMMED ABDU RAHIMAN SAHIB ACADEMIC CHAIR**




## **GANDHI PHOTO EXHIBITION**


## **GANDHI QUIZ**




# NATIONAL SEMINAR

#### **COLLEGE UNION ELECTIONS**













#### **AADHAR-VOTERS ID LINKING INITIATIVE**




