The program successfully educated participants about the potential career prospects within the field of logistics, helping them gain valuable insights into this industry.

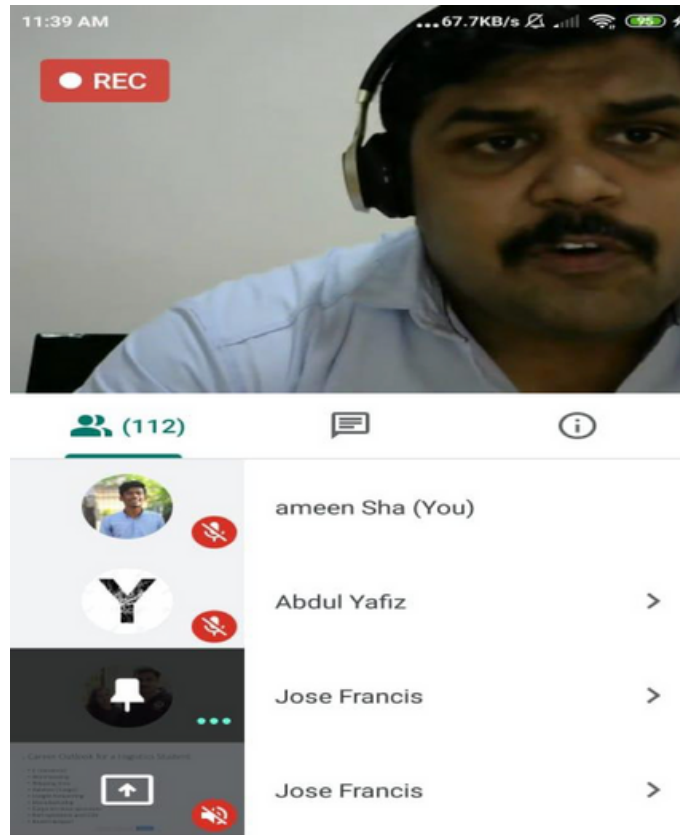
