






TACKLING GENDER BASED VIOLENCE; THERAPEUTIC WORKSHOP FOR STUDENTS

A recent workshop focusing on addressing gender-based violence (GBV) for students was conducted to raise awareness and equip them with the necessary knowledge and skills to prevent and respond to such incidents. Organized by the Department of Psychology in collaboration with the Counselling Cell for College Students, the program took place on February 23, 2023, at the seminar hall. Led by Lathif Penath, Assistant Professor and Head of the Department of Psychology, the workshop aimed to shed light on the issue of gender-based violence, its implications on individuals and society, and strategies for its prevention.

The workshop commenced with an overview of gender-based violence, with facilitators elaborating on its various forms, including physical, sexual, emotional, and psychological abuse. Discussions highlighted the global and local prevalence of GBV, stressing that anyone, irrespective of gender or sexual orientation, can be affected. Moreover, preventive measures were discussed in detail.

THE BIG TALK - COMPREHENSIVE SEXUALITY HEALTH EDUCATION


