ANNUAL REPORT 2020-21

- The current strength of the students in the college is 2089, out of which 1215 are girls. The college is currently running seventeen undergraduate programmes and five post graduate programmes. This year government has sanctioned one post graduate programme, M.Sc Physics with Nano technology as optional subject.
- The college principal Dr. Ajims P Muhammad has been transferred to MES College Marampally and Dr. A Biju joined as new the principal on 8th June 2020
- The College conducted Five Day Faculty Development Programme on Teaching and Learning on Moodle Platform from 20th July 2020 to 24th July 2020.
- Owing to the pandemic situation the college purchased the learning Management system, Moodle. All the students were enrolled in it and the LMS was used extensively. The other online platforms used for online teaching and learning were EDMODO, YouTube channels, Podcasting, Google Classroom etc. Google Hangout, Google meet and Zoom were used to handle live sessions.
- The College conducted Five Day Administrative Training Programme Computer Training on Office Automation from 3rd August 2020 to 7th August 2020.
- Classes for undergraduate programmes started on November 2nd 2020 and PG classes commenced on 30th November.
- The college has 88 teaching staff, of which 47 belong to self-financing courses faculty and there are 29 non – teaching staffs.
