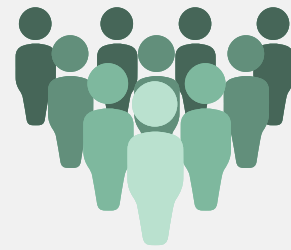




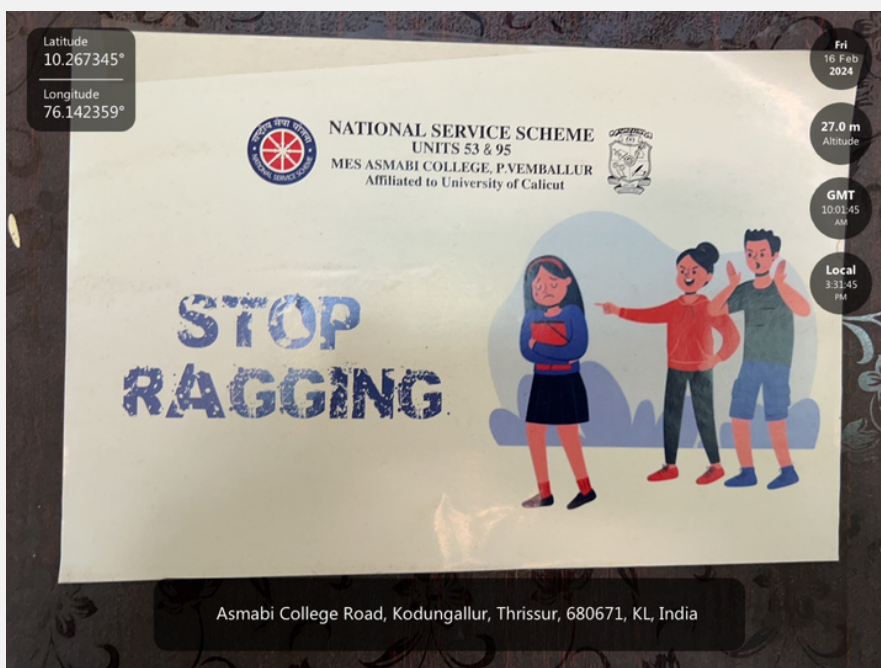

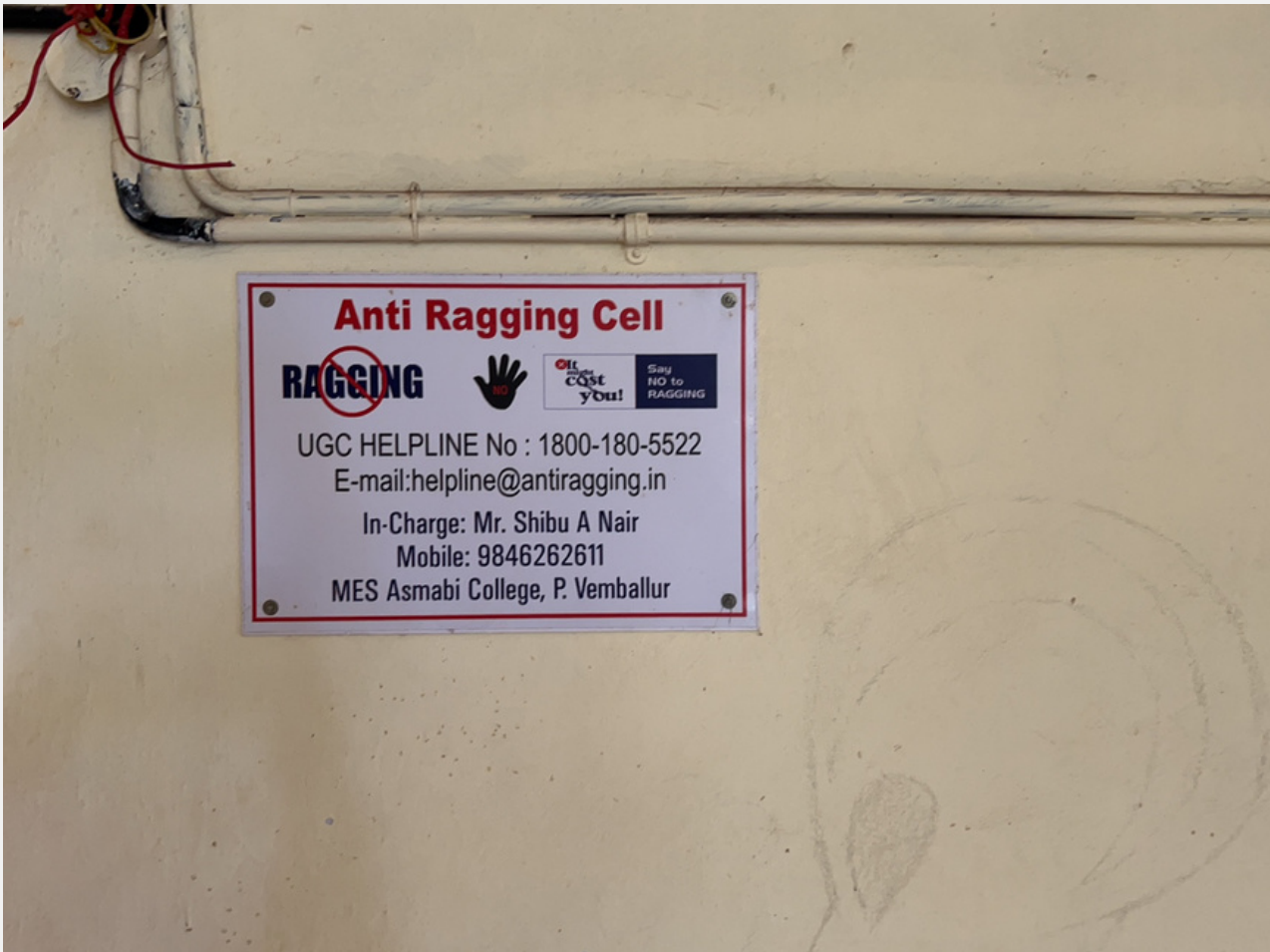


AWARENESS QUOTES

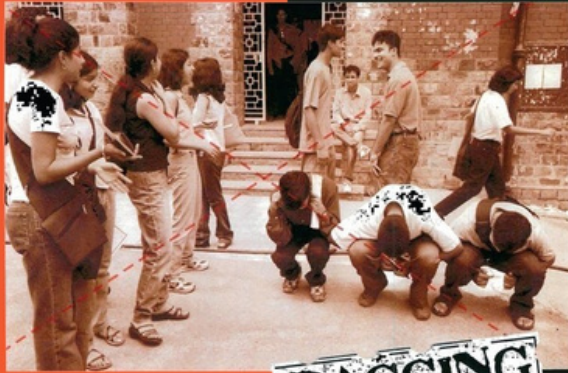
