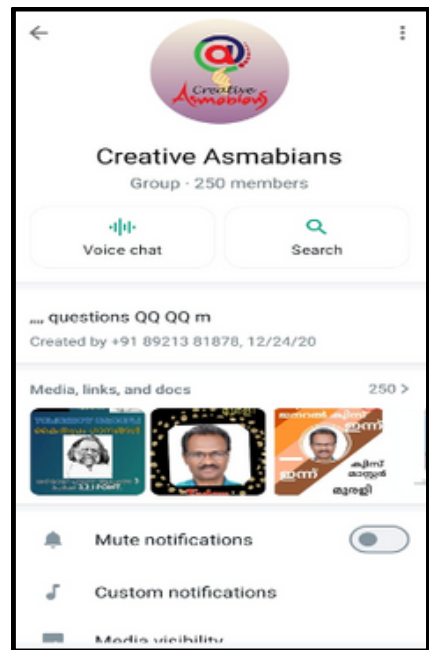
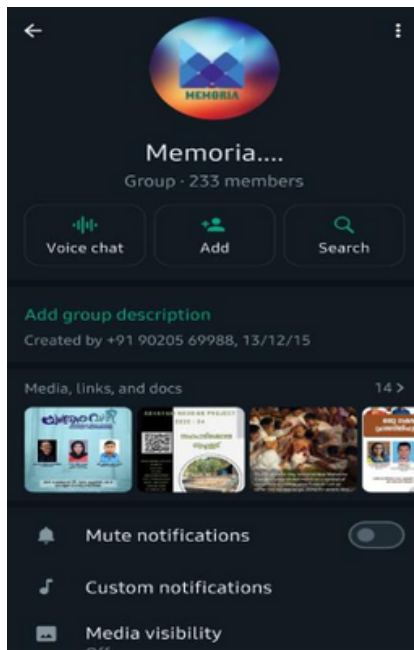
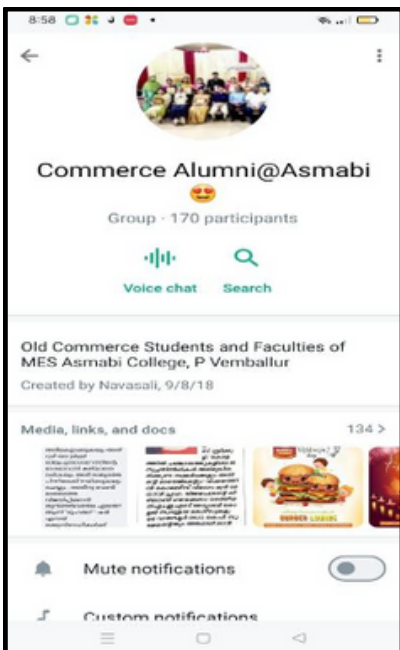
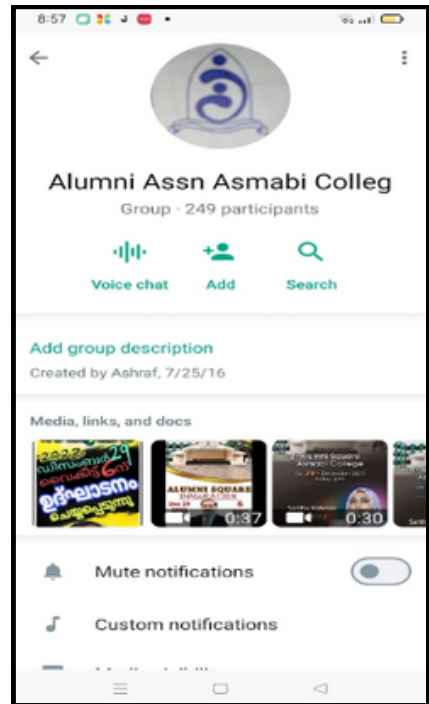
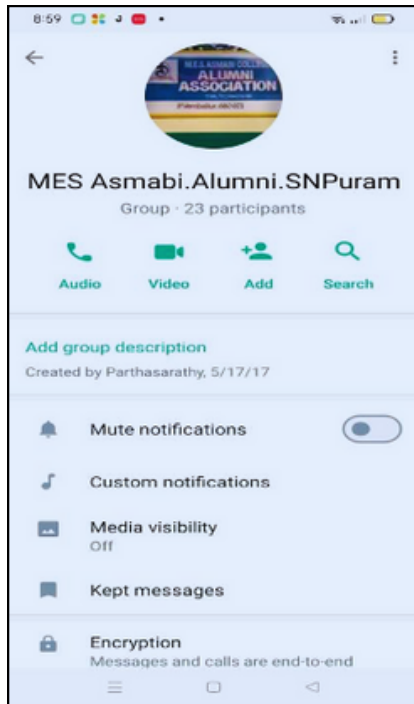
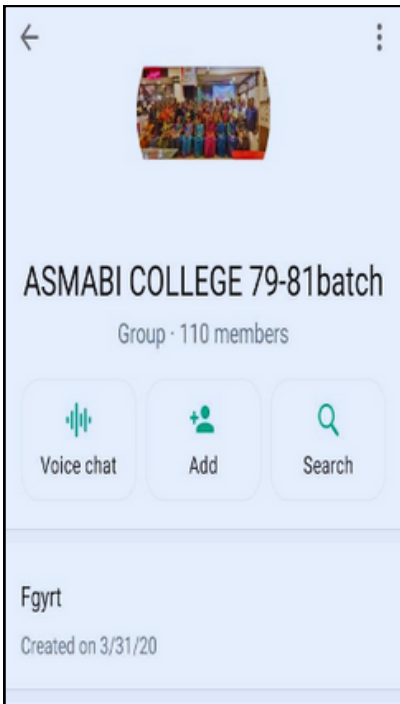
## **Social Media Chapters:**
