The College was established in the year 1968, at P.Vemballur, Kodungallur, a remote coastal backward village in the S.N.Puram Panchayath, of Thrissur District with the objective of uplifting the educationally backward community, of the area who had been denied, the right to education for generations. The college is affiliated to the University of Calicut. The college now caters to the needs of the students throughout Kerala and Lakshadweep, cutting across the barriers of class, caste, creed and religion. The college enjoys 2F and 12B status of the U.G.C. At present it provides higher education to above 2400 students in seventeen Under Graduate programs and five Post Graduate Courses. #### 7. CRITERION RELATED SUMMARY

#### **CRITERION I- CURRICULAR ASPECTS**

MES Asmabi College, P. Vemballur offers 17 UG programmes, 5 PG and 1 PhD programme. College offers 10 various certificate programmes and value added programmes and also organizes different types of curriculum enrichment programmes for students. The curriculum delivery plan and strategic plan of the college ensures measures for effective curriculum delivery. College promoted environmental sustainability consciousness by conducting various programmes through different clubs and forums. Moreover, offers many elective and open courses in different UG and PG programmes in which gender sensitization and professional ethics are incorporated. Institution obtains feedback of the institution from various stake holders such as Students, Teachers, Employers, Alumni etc.

#### **CRITERION II- TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION**

This criterion include various components like student strength, effectiveness of teaching methods, use of modern and innovative teaching techniques, evaluation methods, student satisfaction survey etc. The demand ratio and enrollment percentage of various courses are high in the college. College adopts various student centric teaching methods like, experiential learning, participatory learning and problem solving methods in the teaching learning process. ICT enabled teaching is also implemented in all the departments. OBE is practiced in all programmes and the attainment results are analyzed department-wise and corrective measures are taken when the level of attainment is below the expected level. The number of PhD holders among faculty members is high. Three faculties got national and international awards and many of the faculty members are present in various academic bodies like board of studies and syllabus revision committee. The pass percentage of various courses needs be improved.

#### **CRITERION III- RESEARCH, INNOVATION AND EXTENSION**

The department of Botany in the college is a research centre under the University of Calicut. There are a total of 5 research guides and 10 research scholars in the research centre. The number of research publication is less, and therefore, it should be increased. Regarding the extension and outreach programmes, plenty of activities are conducted in the college. Satisfactory amount of grant is obtained for research in the college from various agencies. Sufficient number of MOUs are present in the college. The IIC, IEDC and IPR cells organise activities, including motivational talks, entrepreneurship development programmes, innovation workshops, and idea hackathons, to raise awareness and provide orientation. The college organized sufficient number of workshops/seminars in IPR, entrepreneurship and research methodology.

#### **CRITERION IV- INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES**

The institution has adequate infrastructure facility for the teaching learning process. The present infrastructure facilities are adequate to meet the current academic and extra-academic needs and are getting upgraded to accommodate future requirements in the wake of radical changes in higher education under NEP 2020. ICT – enabled facilities such as smart classrooms, facilities for cultural and sports activities, laboratory facilities and play grounds for football, kabaddi, badminton, and volleyball, auditorium, seminar halls, recording studio etc.

The activities of various clubs and forums to support students is also remarkable. The placement of students should be promoted in the college by organizing various placement drives.

The institution has a meticulously crafted long-term plan for the next years. The IQAC consistently offers recommendations for enhancing the comprehensive growth of the college through various quality initiatives. Quality audits on environment and energy are regularly undertaken by the institution and moreover, college has many green initiatives in the campus like rain water harvesting unit, solar power unit etc. Use of energy from alternate energy sources has been one of the important

initiatives, adopted since 2017. Based on the analysis provided by the Kerala State Electricity Board, college met half of the energy requirement from the installed solar system. Days of national importance such as Independence Day, Republic Day, Mahatma Gandhi Jayanthi, Yoga Day, Vijay Diwas, Quami Ektha week are regularly observed in the institution. The two best practices of the college are: Best Practice1: 'Gramika': Capacity building, competence for group living, extension, community linkage. This is a programme for the students and faculty of the college to use their expertise and capacity to address issues faced by local community in various fields with the involvement of local bodies, SH groups, NGOs and experts in the local community. Best Practice 2:- Empowering and Capacity building of Marginalised (Tribals, Fishermen, Women and labourers) sections of the society and their institutions through conservation, education, livelihood and natural resource management.
