1. Does all programs/courses were completed on time.	Yes
2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	During the pandemic period the college purchased the learning management system Moodle, which is a platform capable of conducting tests, sharing notes, other materials etc. Edmodo, Telegram, Google Classroom and YouTube channels were also used to make the teaching learning process comfortable. Zoom and Google hangout were used to handle the live sessions effectively. Although offline classes cannot be replaced with online classes, it was the need of the hour to handle the sessions without causing delay in the academic calendar. With proper planning and strategic approach the syllabus of all the courses and programs were completed within the stipulated time period, by making use of both synchronous and asynchronous methods. Teachers in the college usually try to complete the syllabus before time, so as to get ample time for remedial classes and revision. Very rarely some of the teachers could not complete the syllabus on time, because of the nature of some subjects or certain other specific reasons. When there is shortage of time there are certain basic methods adopted to make the process comfortable to the learners. In online mode, at first teachers choose the comparatively easy topics in the syllabus and complete them. It is always better to proceed from the known to the unknown and from the simple to the complex. Generally teachers followed the bilingual method so as to make them more interactive. Participatory learning was promoted so as to avoid boredom. Teachers tried to focus on topics which are frequently asked in exam. Peer learning and evaluation was also promoted. It allowed flexible and personalized learning at the speed of the learner and one can continuously augment and expand content through digital means. Teachers made the students do home works based on the texts physically available to them. Teachers arranged doubt clearing sessions, and remain available at pre-specified times to talk to the learners. Teachers analysed the e-content and e-resources for quality before referring these resources to the students. With digital/online learning, assigning tasks to students is a motivating and engaging factor, accordingly, these were designed. Too much dependence on pen-paper was avoided. Alternative methods of assessment through online classes, social media, blogs and mobile phones were promoted. Students' activities, where alternative modes of assessment like working on projects, portfolios, conducting home-based experiments, interaction with family members and elders, creating prose, poetry and improving literacy skills were assigned to them. These were given timely assessment. Open book examinations were also undertaken. Quality test items were prepared by subject specialists and assessment experts for open book assessment. Students were regularly given positive remarks on their tasks, assignments, replies, questions and responses. Rather than waiting for a completed assignment, whenever students explained the process of doing assignments, they were encouraged. Even in the online mode the college focussed on making the teaching learning process learner centered. By arousing the interest of learners the challenge of handling online sessions to complete the syllabus of courses and programs were successfully carried out effectively within the stipulated period.
