





BASICS OF QUALITATIVE RESEARCH - A HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE

Overview of the Training Programme:

Basics of Qualitative Research - A Hands-on Experience organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The workshop, conducted offline, aimed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of qualitative research methodologies and practical experience in applying these methods. Dr. Arunima KV, a highly experienced faculty member from the Central University of Kerala, served as the resource person, bringing her extensive expertise in research and academia to guide the workshop. The workshop commenced with the welcome speech by Dr Shafeer P. S IQAC Coordinator, Principal Dr. A. Biju, felicitated the participants and speaker.

Session 1: Basic Overview of Qualitative Research

Time: 10:00 am - 11:15 am

The first session of the workshop, titled "Basic Overview of Qualitative Research "laid the foundation for understanding the essentials of qualitative research. Dr. Arunima KV delivered a comprehensive overview and the participants were introduced to the qualitative research approach, which relies on gathering non- numerical data from sources such as interviews, questionnaires, and observations. This approach allows researchers to explore the human experience and perception of various phenomena. She highlighted the differences between quantitative and qualitative research methodologies, emphasizing the strengths and advantages of qualitative research in capturing the nuanced aspects of human behavior and understanding. The session explored various types of qualitative research, including case studies, ethnography, phenomenology, and more. Participants gained insights into choosing the most suitable research approach for their projects. Dr. Arunima discussed the different research paradigms that influence qualitative research, including positivism and interpretive, helping participants align their research with the appropriate paradigm.

Session 2: Research Design for Qualitative Research & Data Collection Methods

Time: 11:30 am - 1:00 pm

In the second session, titled "Research Design for Qualitative Research & Data Collection Methods," participants delved into the practical aspects of conducting qualitative research. Dr. Arunima KV provided insights into the critical process of designing a qualitative research study, including selecting research questions and employing appropriate sampling techniques. The session addressed various methods for collecting qualitative data, such as interviews, focus groups, participant observation, and more and discussed the processes involved in conducting these methods effectively.

Session 3: Reliability and Validity of Qualitative Data

Time: 2:00 pm - 3:15 pm

The third session of the workshop, "Reliability and Validity of Qualitative Data," focused on ensuring the trustworthiness of qualitative research Participants learned about strategies and techniques to maintain the reliability and validity of their qualitative research results. This included discussions on how to minimize bias and errors in data collection and analysis. This section provided an introduction to manual data analysis techniques, such as coding and thematic analysis, which are essential for gaining meaningful insights from qualitative datas

Session 4: Data Analysis, Interpretation, and Reporting

Time: 3:30 pm - 4:45 pm

The final session, "Data Analysis, Interpretation, and Reporting," guided participants through the process of analyzing, interpreting, and reporting qualitative research findings. Participants learned the necessary steps to transcribe and condense qualitative data, making it suitable for analysis. This phase is crucial for ensuring the data's accessibility and usability. Dr. Arunima elaborated on content analysis and thematic mapping as methods to extract meaning from qualitative data. These techniques enable researchers to identify patterns, trends, and insights within their data

The event concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr.Sanand C Sadanandakumar (Joint Coordinator, IQAC). In his speech, Dr.Sanand expressed gratitude to all the participants. About qualitative research and the workshop Qualitative research relies on data obtained by the researcher from first-hand observation, interviews, questionnaires, focus groups, participant-observation, recordings made in natural settings, documents, case studies, and artifacts. The data are generally non-numerical. A good example of a qualitative research method would be unstructured interviews which generate qualitative data through the use of open questions. This allows the respondents to speak freely and in their own words. This aids the researcher in gaining a true feel of a person's perception of a circumstance. The workshop will give participants hands-on experience in a number of qualitative research methods in a simple and practical manner.

GEARING UP FOR SUCCESS THROUGH ADVANCED PREPARATION


