


EXIT SURVEY RESULT

1. Satisfaction on Quality of Education



53.6% of the students expressed satisfaction with the quality of education received from the college.33.9% reported being highly satisfied, while 10.8% reported feeling neutral about their experience. Overall, the majority of respondents are satisfied with the quality of education provided.


2. Approachable and Helpful Attitude of the Teachers



49.4% of the students state that their teachers are highly approachable, while 42.4% acknowledge their teachers as approachable and helpful. A remaining 7.4% adopt a neutral


stance. This comprehensive analysis suggests a prevailing sentiment among students that their teachers are indeed accessible and supportive.

3. Qualification and Knowledge of Teachers




50.4% of the students opined that their teachers are highly knowledgeable, while 46.6% acknowledge their teachers as knowledgeable. Overall it shows that teachers are knowledgeable.

4. Campus Classroom Facilities




52.6% of respondents acknowledge that the campus classroom facilities are good, with an additional 26.7% rating them as excellent. Another 15.1% remain neutral. Collectively, these responses suggest a positive perception of the campus classroom facilities as being good and they are impressed about it.

5. Canteen Facility in the Campus





6.Health and wellness services.





7. Effectiveness of Career Counselling and Placement Services





8. Sports Activities and Facilities





9.Arts Club Facilities





10. ICT resources





11. Opinion on College Culture




