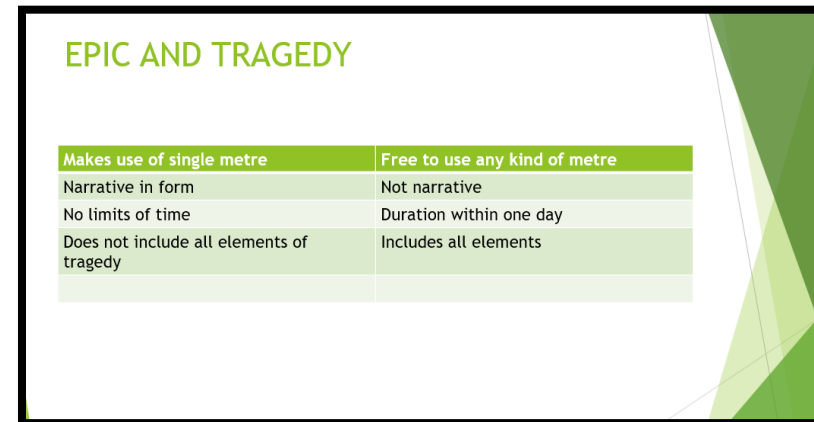
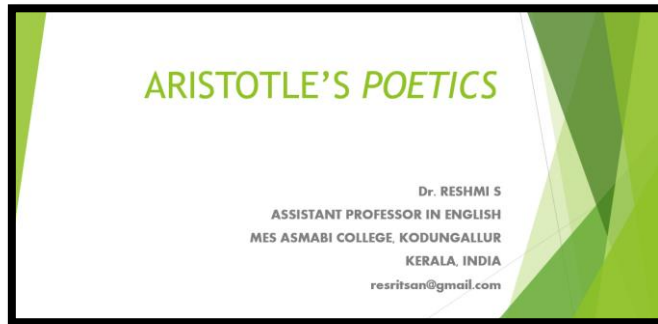
ICT TEACHING USING YOUTUBE

PLATO AND ARISTOTLE

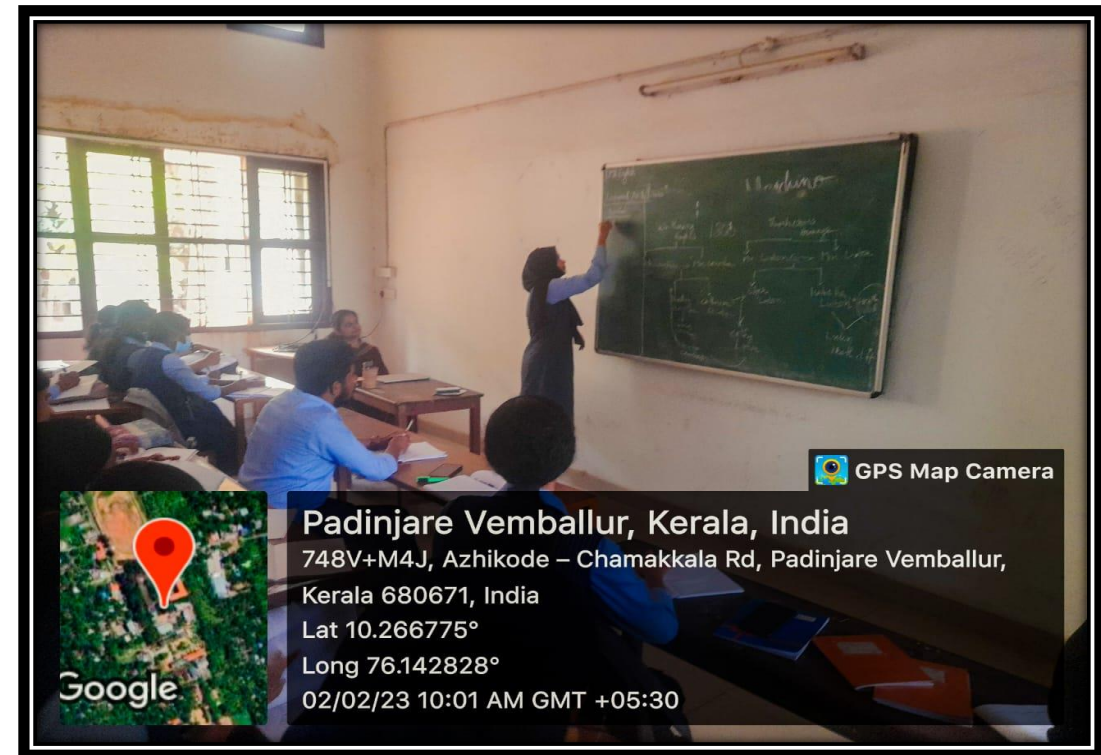
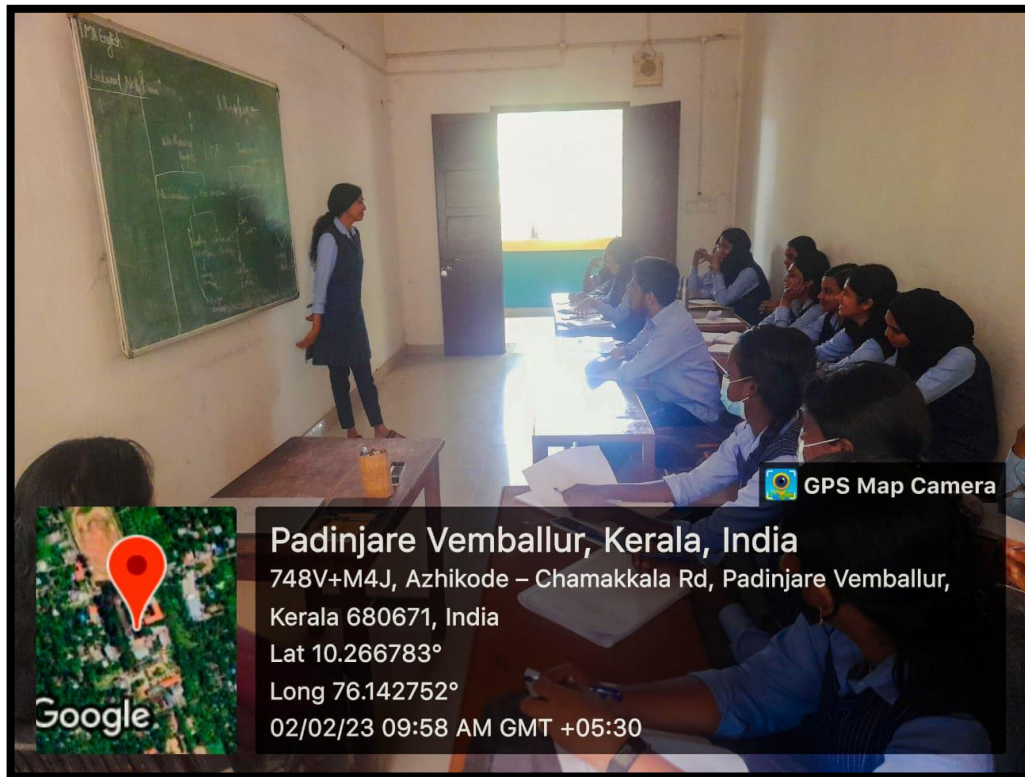
- Plato is idealistic in thinking- Aristotle is pragmatic

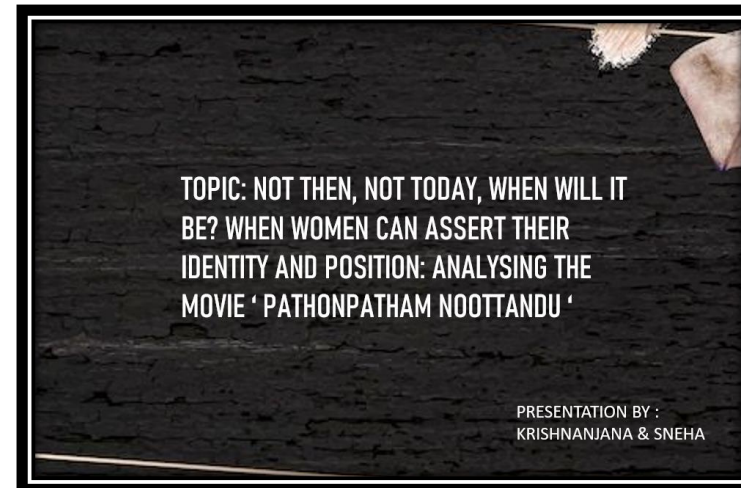

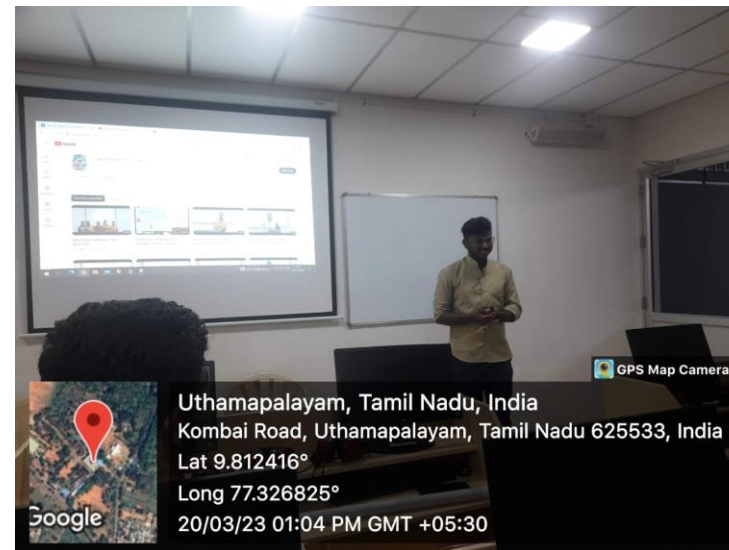

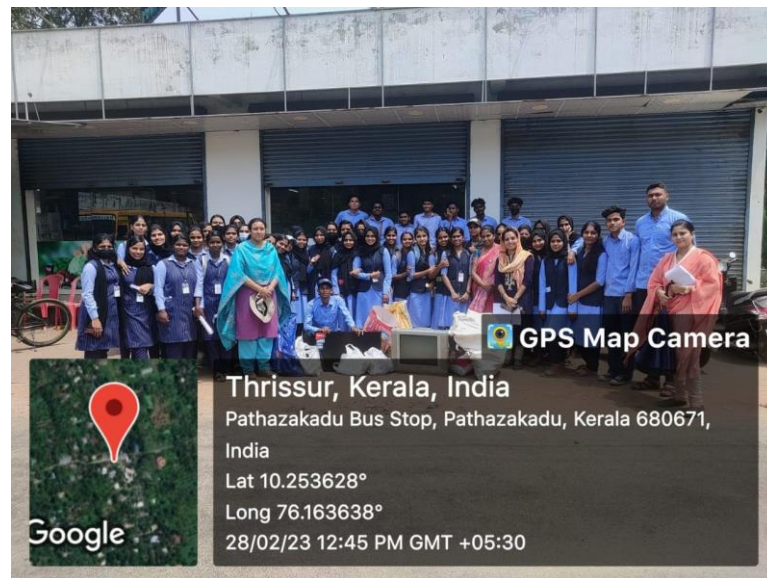

Best solution from a student has been attached as it incorporated all the necessary formal steps and procedures. A scientific analysis has been made by the student to demonstrate identity as a serious issue governing the society due to multiculturalism and racism.

PROBLEM SOLVING

PROBLEM :- Analyzing the theme of identity in the novel 'White Teeth' by Zadie Smith.

SOLUTION :-

1) Identify the problem →

Through the detailed reading and analysis of the novel 'White Teeth' written by Zadie Smith, it can be found that the novel delves into the theme of identity in the context of cultural diversity and generational shifts. Through the experiences of her diverse cast of characters, Smith takes an in-depth look at the ways people adapt, or fail to adapt, to living in a multicultural society.



2) Analyze the evidence →

4) Gather and analyze information →

The novel highlights the theme of identity which focuses on the construction of personal identity within a diaspora and the problem of self-determination in relation to a white 'mainstream' society which confronts people of different origin with racism and misrecognition, and automatically labels them as different. The novel itself provides information about the theme of identity along with several external sources of information.

5) Define the scope →

'White Teeth' focuses on the postmodern times and in particular, the construction of the identity of the Bangladeshi (Samad Iqbal) and the Englishman (Archibald Jones) who are two close friends.

6) Formulate a thesis statement →

Zadie Smith's 'White Teeth' explores the theme of identity in such a way that the characters in the novel, particularly those with immigrant backgrounds, grapple with questions of identity as they navigate their lives in multicultural London. The narrative explores the complexities of defining oneself in a society marked by various cultural influences and expectations.

7) Provide evidence →

The theme of identity is intricately woven into the narrative of 'White Teeth' through various characters and their experiences. Archie's identity crisis is evident in his search for himself in his life. Samad's

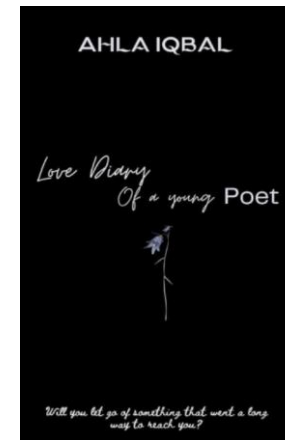
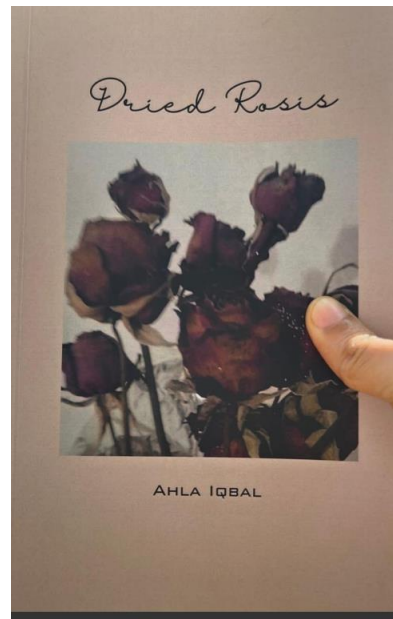
8) Provide recommendations →

CREATIVE WRITING AND PUBLISHING

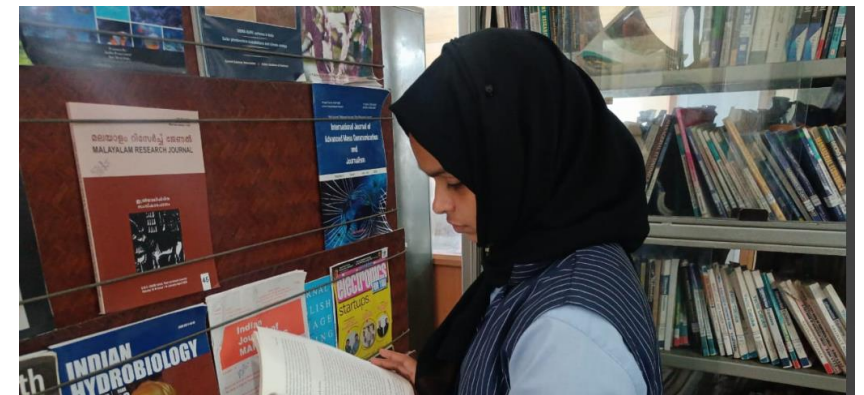
