
# **WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION**


# **YOGA DAY PROGRAMME**






#### WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY








### WORLD ALZHEIMER'S DAY

The National Cinema Day event held on October 13, 2023, at MES Asmabi College was a remarkable tribute to the late legendary Director KG George. Organized by the


Department of Digital Film Production, the event comprised two main segments: Film Screening and Poster Recreation.

# NATIONAL TOURISM DAY


