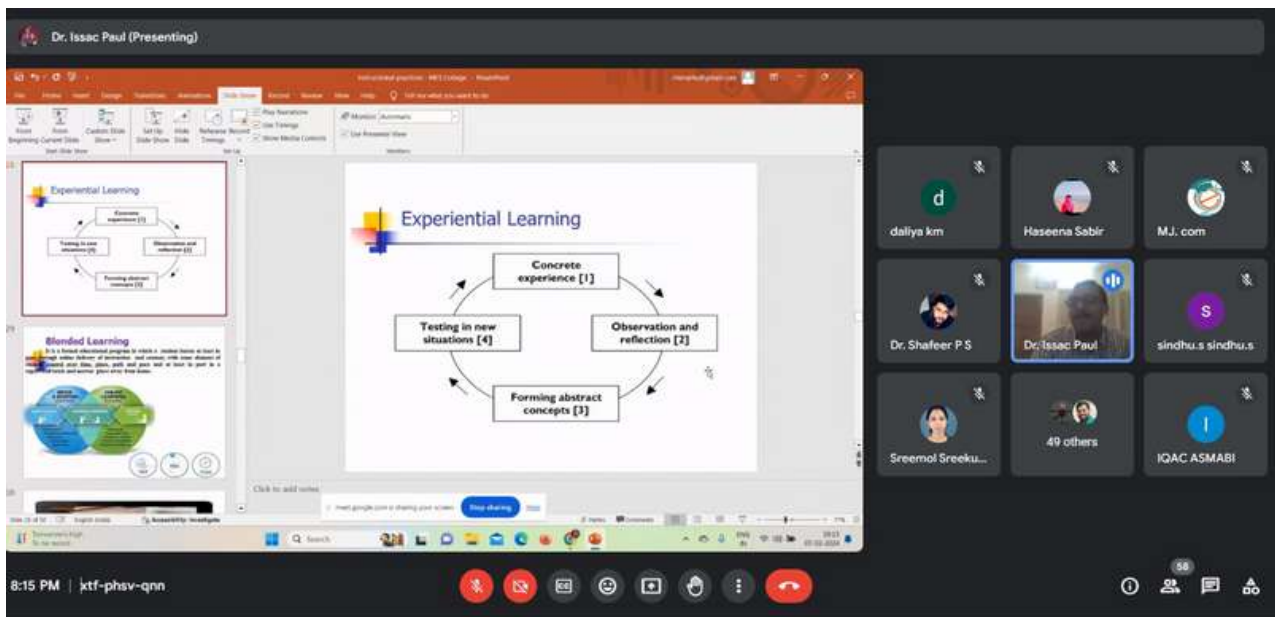

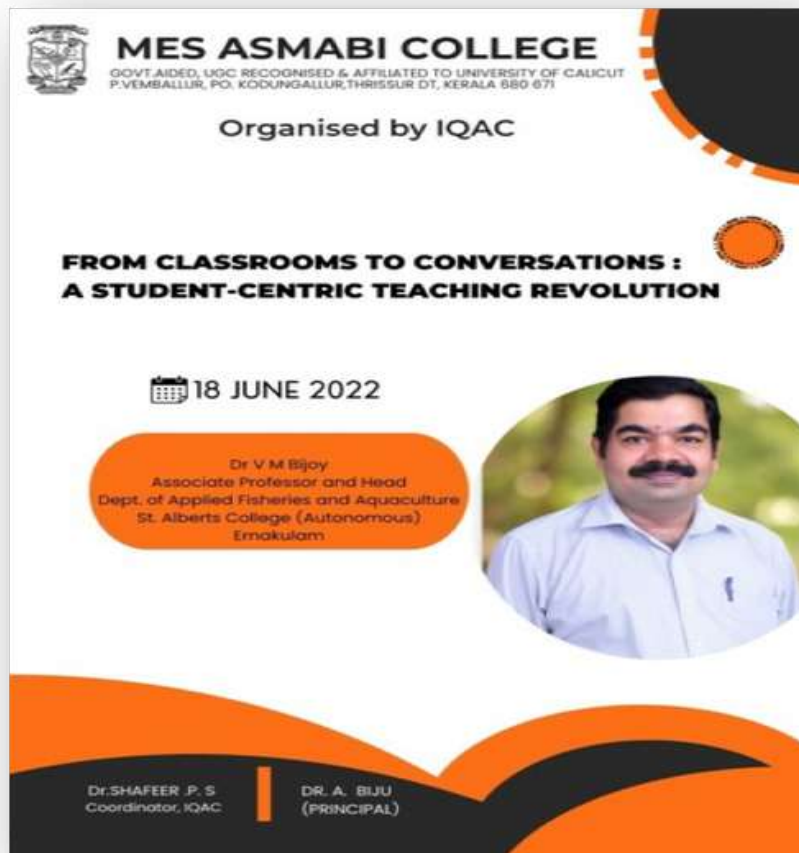
Dr V M Bijoy took the stage to lead the discussion on student-centric teaching. His session covered various aspects, including:

- Inclusive Teaching Practices

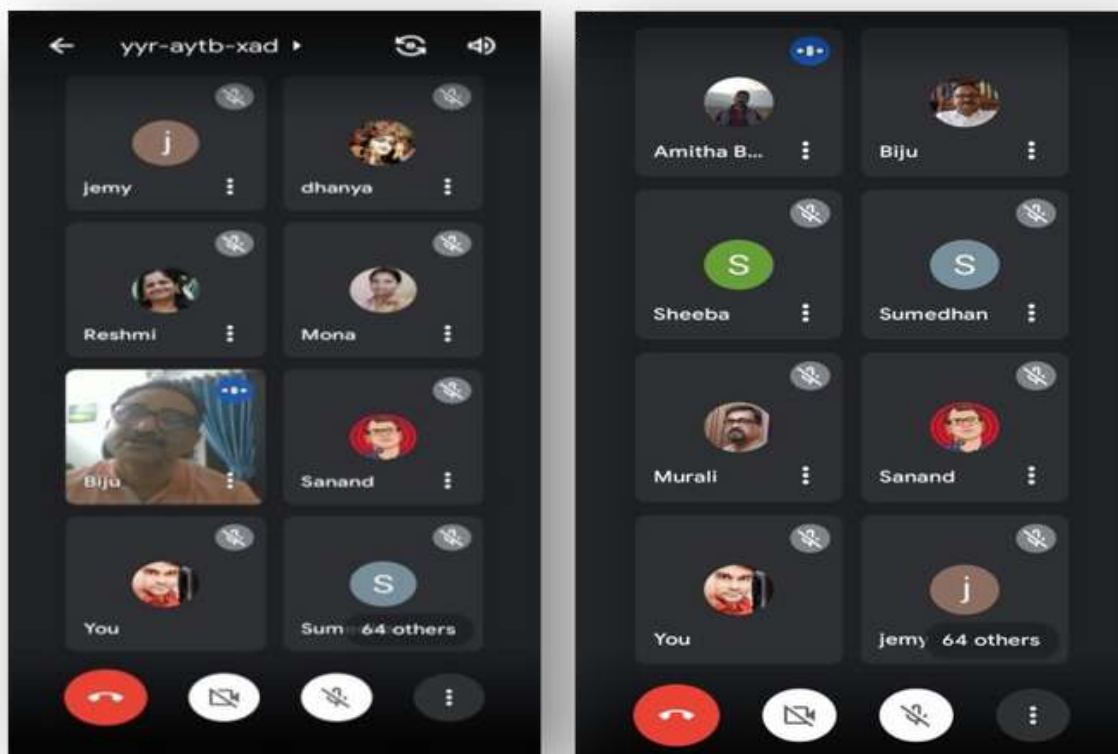
The program provided a platform for educators to explore and discuss innovative teaching practices that prioritize student engagement.

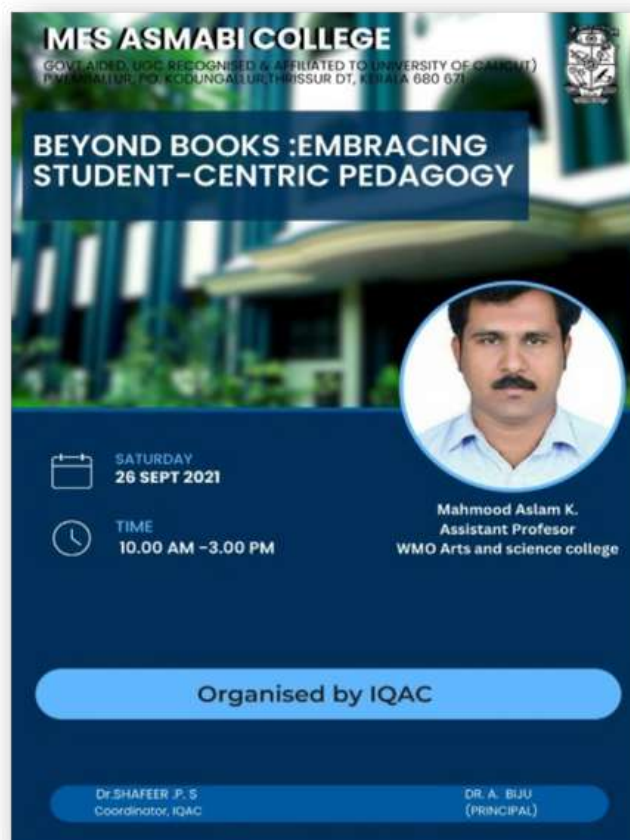
