The session included :

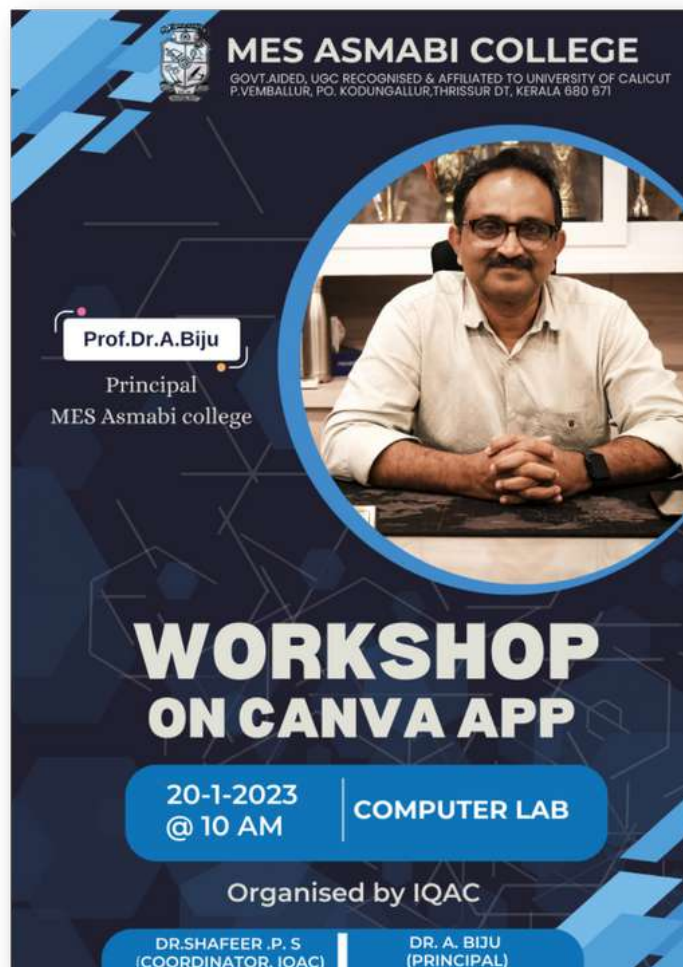
·Introduction to Canva
