Basics of Short Film Making

Unit – I History of Film, types of film genres, concept of short film and documentary, what is pre-production, production and post production, role of a director, story, screen play, dialogue, locations, art direction, character building, shot, scene, camera angle and movement, shot division, visual composition, continuity, 180-degree rule.

Unit – II Role of a cinematographer, camera and Smartphone camera functions and controls, color theory & basic lighting techniques, introduction to camera tools and equipment, camera handling, dubbing, sound recording.

Unit – III Significance of an editor, basics of editing, introduction to Adobe Premiere Pro, DaVinci Resolve software, types of cuts and transition, color correction, adding sound and music.

Unit – IV Film ethics, film society, planning and budgeting, selection of topics for documentary and short film, hands-on creating and submitting documentary and short films, short film festivals.
