The program was inaugurated by Mr. Rajan, President, Eriyad Grama Panchayath and Mr. Febin Francis, Thrissur District Coordinator Kerala State Biodiversity Board by planting mangrove saplings. Dr. K.H. Amitha Bachan gave his speech and encouraged the volunteers from the Bhoomithrasea club. All the elected member of the Panchayath, administrative staff and AE MGNREGA and 286 women from the MGNREGA scheme of three wards of Eriyad Grama Panchayath participated in the program and planted 850 saplings of different mangrove species in the suitable pre identified locations following the procedures ecosystems based and Niche specific restoration.
