All 13 departments have their own department alumni association. Departments annual general meetings were conducted every year and parent body stand in shoulder to shoulder to achieve the common objectives of the association.




















CONTRIBUTIONS TO CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT

Alumni and PTA sponsored Examination Hall (20 Lakhs)

The Alumni Association has been involved in many development activities of the college by taking up the construction of the examination hall and inauguration on 21 October 2019. New examination hall which is named 'Winners' Hall .It is constructed on the 4th floor of commerce block and is a vast hall of about 5000sqft amounting up to 20 lakhs PTA contributed 3 lakhs and the rest was met by Alumni Association Works were started in a dilemma as there was no idea regarding the fund to complete. But our benevolent Alumni& retired staff provided adequate funds and the work was finished well before time.





Alumni Square (25 lakhs)

The alumni association also plays a key role in fundraising for the institution. By reaching out to alumni and soliciting donations, the association helps to support the institution's mission and programs. To commemorate the Silver Jubilee Year, the association decided to construct Alumni Square, a spacious stage with a green room and bathroom. The construction of the building is currently underway with an estimated cost of 25 lakhs to finalize.








Inspiratio: Alumni Lecture Series








SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTION

Covid Relief Activity- Distribution of Smartphones During COVID-19

Due to the Covid pandemic, all classes had to convert to online mode. Unfortunately, this sudden shift created several problems for students. A significant issue was the lack of smartphones, which students many afford couldn't to purchase. The principal compiled a list of these students and reached out to the association for help. The association quickly responded and appealed to its members to contribute towards the purchase of smartphones. We were able to collect INR 2,80,000 in a short period, which allowed us to buy forty smartphones for the affected students.







AWARDING GOLD MEDALS

The Alumni Association has been awarding gold medals to the class toppers of the college for the last thirteen years, to recognize their merit and encourage other students to enhance their academic achievements. Last 5 years 89 gold medals were distributed to the college toppers. Even during covid 19 gold medal distributions have been organized. Prominent alumnae from home and abroad usually sponsor these gold medals. It is given to almost all the toppers in different departments and Scholarships to students who need financial support.







To help flood-affected students of the college, the Pravda College Union along with College Management conducted a musical event "koode" on 27.09.2018.




Association's Annual Family Meet: A Tradition Since 2003














'ORMAKAY-' Annual Publication of Alumni Directory
