


Students' centric teaching learning workshop


Monitored the effectiveness of online classes during covid

Department of Psychology


NATIONAL WEBINAR ON MENTAL HEALTH FOR ALL- GREATER INVESTMENT, GREATER ACCESS

The training successfully empowered the non-teaching staff with the knowledge and tools needed to streamline administrative processes and enhance overall effectiveness.




PARTICIPATION IN NIRF 2020-21

NAAC ACCREDITATION THROUGH EFFECTIVE DOCUMENTATION



On September 26, 2020, the PG Department of Commerce and IQAC at Co-Operative Arts and Science College, Madayi, in collaboration with the IQAC and Research Department

Stakeholder Feedback and SSS Results

The feedback mechanisms showed sustained satisfaction, with particular praise for the adaptation to online learning platforms during the pandemic.

Monitoring of Progression

The progression rate to the higher education and employment are 49.65% (284 out of 572), likely influenced by the challenging external environment, including the pandemic's impact on job markets.

AAA Internal Assessment

The AAA underscored the successful transition to digital education and recommended further investment in online learning tools and faculty training.

AQAR Preparation

Despite pandemic challenges, the AQAR was completed, showcasing the college's resilience and adaptability in maintaining quality education.

Departmental Visits and File Verification

Audits focused on the effectiveness of remote teaching practices and the digital readiness of departments, with a push for enhanced e-learning resources.

Certificate Courses and Enrolment

Enrollment surged to 2,285 students across 29 courses, reflecting a heightened demand for online learning options.

Result Analysis

The pass percentage was 78.90%, demonstrating the institution's effective handling of the transition to online education.
