PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION REPORT 2024-2025

The Parent Teacher Association (PTA) actively contributed to various initiatives during the academic year 2024-2025. A total of five Executive Committee meetings and two General Body meetings were conducted. At the beginning of the academic year, Dr. Reena Mohammed assumed charge as the new Principal and President of the PTA, while Dr. Sanand C. Sadananda Kumar, Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Science, took charge as Secretary.

General Body Meetings and Executive Committee

The first General Body meeting was held on August 9, 2024, where new executive members Mr.Thalhath and Mrs.Balkis Banu were elected. In this meeting, former Principal Dr. A. Biju conducted an orientation session for parents in preparation for the upcoming NAAC visit.The PTA played a major role in the NAAC evaluation process, particularly in interactive sessions with parents. The college was successfully accredited with a CGPA of 3.19 (A Grade).

Infrastructure Development

The PTA played a significant role in infrastructure development by:

- Purchasing chairs for the new seminar hall at a cost of Rs 2 lakhs.
- Procuring a Laser Projector, HDMI cable, ceiling mount kit, and roll-up screen for the college auditorium at Rs 2.5 lakhs to facilitate major events.
- Purchasing language lab software worth Rs 1.3 lakhs to enhance students' language skills, including proficiency in two European languages.

Contributions to Sports

- Rs 10,000 was contributed for hiring a coach for the college Kabaddi team.
- Rs 10,000 was provided to Saliha (B.Sc. Physics student) for participating in the All India
 University Grappling Competition.

- Rs 1.5 lakhs was sanctioned for purchasing mats for Boxing, Wrestling, and Wushu
 practice, as requested by the Physical Education Department.
- Rs 50,000 was sanctioned for the coach's remuneration for one year.

Support for Arts & Cultural Activities

- Rs 60,000 was provided at the beginning of the academic year for the Fine Arts Club to train the college dance team. The team participated in several competitions across the state and won prizes worth Rs 1.25 lakhs.
- Rs 4,80,000 was contributed to the Arts Club for participation in the Calicut University D Zone Competition, leading to remarkable achievements.
- Following the university-level competition, Rs 1,85,740 was funded for further participation, leading to first prizes in Arabana Muttu, Duff Muttu, and Parichamuttu.
- At the end of the academic year, the Fine Arts team refunded Rs 52,000 to the PTA fund.

Other Contributions

- Rs 35,000 was provided as sponsorship for two students of Tourism and Hospitality
 Management to cover their compulsory study trip expenses.
- Rs 10,000 was paid for the medical treatment of a college security staff member.
- Rs 1,00,000 was donated to the NSS Abhayam Project, which aims to construct a home for a needy student.
- Rs 15,000 was provided for the College Union Inauguration program.
- Rs 15,000 was allocated for newspaper renewal in the college library.
- Rs 13,915 was paid each month as salary for the college bus driver.
- Rs 10,000 was allocated each month for additional guest lecturers on contract.

• Rs 5,000 was allocated each month for counseling facilities throughout the year.

Annual General Body Meeting & Honoring Achievements

During the Annual General Body Meeting, Rs 95,000 was distributed as scholarships to 95 students, one from each class along with the outgoing batch. Achievers in sports, arts, and other competitions were honored with mementos. Additionally, retiring Office Superintendent Sri Sadarudeen and MES Award-winning faculty member Dr. Amita Bachan were honored. A memento was also presented to Dr. Rameena K.A. from the Department of Commerce for
