
Strategic Plan for the Conservation of Sacred Grove: Project Completion Program

Western Ghats Hornbill Foundation prepare a Strategic Plan for the Conservation, Monitoring, and Ecorestoration of Coastal Ecosystems and its Biodiversity within the SN Puram Grama Panchayath.



The first phase of Monitoring and restoration was completed in Sanghukulangara Kavu in collaboration with SN Puram Gramapanchyath, BMC, Kizhakootu kudumba trust and MES Asmabi College. The programme was inaugurated by Mr. E. T. Tyson Master, Hon. MLA, Kaipamangalam constituency on 26th August 2021 at Sangukulangara Kavu in the auspicious presence of M. Mohanan, President SN Puram Grama Panchayat, Members of the trust Mr. Raghunath and other members of the trust, Ward member and Mr. Febin, District coordinator, Kerala State Biodiversity Board and Mr. Ratheesh Convenor, Biodiversity Management Committee of Sree Narayanapuram Grama Panchayat. Dr. K.H. Amitha Bachan and three teachers and 15 students were participated. Mr. E. T. Tyson Master inaugurated the plants name boards. It helps to identify the plant species.

Dr. K.H. Amitha Bachan presented a brief study report in the meeting. 172 plants identified in Sanku kulangara kavu. 20 plant species were endangered. 107 birds and 32 mushroom species were identified. These shows that this Kavu was the important ecosystem in the coastal region. Human interventions and climate change affect the degradation of the kavu. The long term monitoring, Community based conservation and management needed to restore the Kavu.
