
## Webinar series on Malabar Rebellion centenary- Day 3

The webinar series on the centenary of the Malabar Rebellion was conducted on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2021 at 3pm via Google Meet. The webinar was intended to bring together scholars, historians, and experts to delve into various aspects of this historical event. The event was organized by the Department of History, Department of Political Science, and IQAC of MES Asmabi College, Kodungallur, in collaboration with Mahakavi Moyinkutty Vaidyar Kerala Mappila Kala Academy, Kondotty.

The day commenced with a session focusing on the historical background of the Malabar Rebellion. The Malabar rebellion of 1921 was a series of armed revolts by Mappila Muslims against the British and Hindu landlords in Malabar, Northern Kerala. The rebellion was also a resistance against the feudal system controlled by elite Hindus. The rebellion began in the 19th century and culminated in August 1921 with a number of riots in the southern taluks of Malabar. A M Shinas & Dr Srividya Vattarambath Eminent historians shed light on the socio-political dynamics leading to the rebellion, providing attendees with a comprehensive understanding of the events that unfolded.

The webinar encouraged active participation from the audience through live Q&A sessions after each presentation. Social media platforms were utilized for audience interaction, allowing attendees to share their thoughts, questions, and reflections.
