## PTA report for the year 2023- 24

In the year 2023-24, there are four PTA executive committee meetings, two general body meetings and one hostel inmates meeting were conducted. The general body meetings were conducted on 12-09-2023 and 21-03-2024. As per the decisions taken in the PTA executive committee meeting the following actions/programs were taken during the academic year.

- 1. An amount of rupees 1, 15,000(one lakh fifteen thousand) was given to 110 students (including 5 rank holders) as scholarship for their excellent performances in academic and non-academic subjects.
- 2. Dr Shahija and Dr Rameesha of the Commerce department were honoured for achieving PhD.
- 3. Dr. Sheena P. A and Sri. Shibu A Nair, the teachers retiring from the college after 30 years of teaching experience were honoured.
- 4. An amount of rupees eleven lakh ninety-seven thousand eight hundred and ninety-four (11, 97,894) was given from the PTA fund for purchasing a printer for the college.
- 5. An amount of seven lakh (7, 00,000) was expended for constructing the rainwater harvesting tank for the college.
- 6. An amount of fifty-eight thousand six hundred and forty six (58,646) was expended for installing the incinerators in the bathroom.
- 7. Financial assistance of rupees sixty-one thousand six hundred and seventy-six (61,676) was given to students for medical expenses, travelling expenses and participating in sports activities viz. football, boxing, University athletic meets, national championships etc.
- 8. An amount of rupees six lakh eighty-six thousand and six hundred and five (6, 86,605) was granted for fine arts programs. It included dance training, training for D-Zone and inter-zone activities.
- 9. As has been done in the previous years, sufficient financial assistance was given for the functioning of NSS programs.
- 10. The remuneration for the guest faculties working in the Botany department is paid from the PTA fund.
- 11. For the benefit of the students, various programs like NET coaching, pathway social life wellness program, anti-drug program, vimukti etc. were conducted with the financial assistance of the PTA.
- 12. Financial assistance was given to both teachers and students for FDP, participating in various programs like international conferences, international paper presentations etc.

- 13. Financial assistance was also given for conducting National seminars, psychological counselling classes etc.
- 14. A student from B. Com Co-operation has been given financial assistance from PTA since January 2024.
- 15. All the expenses relating to the college website, College bus purchase of newspapers and subscription to hostel Wi-Fi etc. are being met from the PTA fund.
- 16. In case of emergency, the travelling expenses of students to hospital are being met by the PTA.
- 17. An amount of One lakh fifty thousand (1, 50,000) was donated for the construction of College Alumni Square.
- 18. An external audit of the PTA fund account for the period from 1-4-2023 to 31-3-2024 was conducted.
